THE HISTORY

Richard Ormonde won the first ever British Grand Prix held at Donnington in 1935 but unfortunately died in a flying accident in 1940. He was only 35 years old.

His devastated mother formed the Shuttleworth Remembrance Trust in his honour, and Old Warden Park, together with the Shuttleworth Collection, have become his memorial for us to enjoy.
